Regulations

1. The total credits required for graduation are 32 credits (comprising 9 required credits, 17 elective credits, and 6 thesis credits).
2. Credits per semester: First-year students may register for 6–16 credits in their first semester; all other semesters allow 3–16 credits.
3. Students must either complete the academic ethics course offered by the Taiwan Academic Ethics Education Resources Center and obtain a certificate of completion, or attend at least 6 hours of academic ethics-related workshops and obtain a certificate of participation. When applying for the master's thesis oral examination, students must submit one of the aforementioned certificates; only upon review and approval may the application for the oral examination proceed.
4. Students may take courses required for their research from master's programs in other departments of the University. Credits earned from such courses and approved by the department may be counted toward elective graduation credits for the department's master's program, up to a maximum of 3 credits. Students may also take courses at graduate institutes of other universities if such courses are not offered by the department's master's program; however, only one course, up to a maximum of 3 credits, may be counted, and the credits earned shall be included in the calculation of elective credits taken from other departments' master's programs.
5. Other Courses: Courses approved by the Graduate Institute.
6. Students admitted to the master's program under Article 7 of the "Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for University Admission" shall receive course consultation and guidance provided by professional faculty members of the department. Such courses and guidance shall not be included in the calculation of graduation credits.
