## Regulations

1. The minimum graduation requirement is 128 credits, including 28 university-required credits, 9 college-required credits, 55 department-required credits, and 36 professional elective credits.
2. The number of credits to be taken each semester is as follows: students in the first through third year shall take 16–25 credits per semester, while fourth-year students shall take 9–25 credits per semester. Detailed regulations shall be governed by the University Academic Regulations.
3. In accordance with the University’s Guidelines for Chinese Proficiency Assessment, English Proficiency Assessment, Information Literacy Assessment, and Physical Fitness Assessment, students must pass the required assessments in Chinese proficiency, English proficiency, information literacy, and physical fitness in order to graduate.
4. Students must meet the assessment standards specified in the Department’s Professional Competency Assessment Guidelines in order to graduate.
5. Information technology certifications obtained by students through passing the University's Information Literacy Assessment shall be recognized by the Department as basic workplace information application certifications.
6. Students may take courses offered by other departments if such courses are not available in this Department. Upon departmental approval, a maximum of 8 credits (including interdisciplinary program credits) may be counted toward professional elective credits. Students may also take courses at other universities if such courses are not offered by this Department; however, only one course may be taken. Credits earned from other universities shall be included in the calculation of external elective credits and shall be subject to the University’s Intercollegiate Course Selection Regulations.
7. Students who have obtained a Class A Women’s Dressmaking Technician Certificate prior to taking “Garment Construction” (3 elective credits in the first semester of the third year) and “Advanced Garment Construction” (3 elective credits in the second semester of the third year) may apply for course exemption.
8. Students participating in the Ministry of National Defense Reserve Officers’ Training Corps (ROTC) program who have completed the required winter and summer training and obtained certification may apply for exemption from the Department’s internship courses and credits, up to a maximum of 10 credits. Students applying for exemption from a full-semester internship must complete registration and enroll in at least one additional course during the internship semester.
9. For the courses “Professional Internship” and “Fashion Industry Internship” in this department, each credit hour is limited to a maximum of 80 internship hours for students.
